Guided tour to Creery area

ABOUT 35 people joined Peel Preservation Group member Marion Timms for a walk across the Creery conservation area recently.

The walkers saw the regeneration of the samphire marsh and the return of many native species on the sand rises of the 86.5ha area.

They heard how many varieties of seeds were collected from natural plant species, both freshwater

and salt-tolerant, and later sown in appropriate areas, of the many setbacks and how 30kg of seed were collected, propagated and planted.

Another walk is planned for autumn.
